Cape Namibia Route Etosha Extension Tour 6 days/ 5 nights 2010/2011 For CPTNAMEX01

NOTE:

This is an extension tour for the Cape Namibia Route (CPTNAMEX01). Departure dates for this ETOSHA TOUR will be on the 13th of every month from February 2011 to November 2011 and must be booked and confirmed at least 3 months in advance.

The Namibia Cape Route (NAMCPTDI01) is a scheduled tour that commences 2 days after the completion of the Cape Namibia Route (CPTNAMEX01). The Etosha extension tour will leave Ai-Aiba Rock Painting Lodge early morning of the 13th (DAY 13) where we will turn North, en-route to our 3 day/4 night destination at Naua Naua Game Lodge.

ETOSHA

A visit to the Etosha National Park is one of the highlights of travelling Namibia. Etosha, which was declared a game reserve by the German colonial administration back in 1907, covers an area of more than 22 000 square kilometers. In its centre lies a vast saltpan surrounded by grass and thorn savannah, Mopane bush land in the west and dry forest in the north-east. About two million years ago, this area was an enormous lake, fed by the Kunene River. However the lake slowly dried up because over time, the river changed its course. The Etosha National Park has a good infrastructure. Well-maintained gravel roads (untarred) leads to the waterholes, where game viewing is at its best. In the three rest camps Okaukuejo, Halali and Namutoni, hotels, chalets and camping sites are available as well as restaurants, stores and swimming pools.

The main entrance to the park is called the "Andersson Gate" at Okaukuejo in the south, where the park administration is also situated. The "Von Lindequist Gate" lies in the east near Namutoni. A new gate, the "Nehale Iya Mpingana Gate" (King Nehale Gate) was opened at the beginning of 2003 in the north-east.

The pan is just about always dry. However, in the southern parts there are have water-holes scattered throughout this area and form the basis of life for countless game. Be it a lion or an elephant, a giraffe or a zebra; almost all African animal species are represented in the huge nature reserve, approx. 22 000 square kilometres in size. There is an estimated number of 250 lions in the park, 300 rhinos, 2 500 giraffes, 6 000 zebras and more than 2 000 elephants. The dainty springbok are especially numerous; at least 20 000 of them roam the reserve. Often, they can be observed in enormous herds of several hundred animals.

Day 13 to Day 16: Naua Naua Game Lodge

Allow yourself to be enticed by untouched nature and inspired by tranquillity. Enjoy the luxurious ambience coupled with adventure and safari. Our thatched lodge integrates perfectly with the surrounding landscapes and is situated in the north of Namibia, close to the Etosha National Park (southern entrance – Anderson Gate).

Due to its special location on a mountain slope, the lodge affords spectacular vistas across Africa's thorn-bush savannah and wildlife. Observe diverse game species that gather at a nearby watering hole by day and night, from the pool deck or your terrace while sipping a well-chilled drink. Relax around the swimming pool or participate in some of the varied activities.

The unique cheetah feed followed by sundowners enjoyed at a view point is an experience not to be missed. Watching the sun set slowly on the horizon of Namibia's vast wide open landscapes creates truly unforgettable memories. Game viewing is best done in the cool of the early morning or late afternoon.

Activities included:

- 2 Full days Etosha Game Drive. Spend the last day (16) to explore the farm or be at leisure at the pool.

Activities excluded:

- Guided night drives provided by NWR (Namibia Wildlife Resorts)
