- Min. 2/Max. 6 passengers per 1st 4x4 vehicle and Min. 2/Max.4 passengers per 2nd/3rd vehicle will continue to apply to all such tour departures.
- 3rd person prices for children up to 18 years of age apply only, if accommodation and vehicle are shared with 2 full-paying tour participants. Children staying in own rooms and 3rd adult (18+ years) sharing room will be charged at the full tour price.
- All our safaris, except "Namibia Premier" are suitable for children of any age. We recommend though that families with children under the age of 8 years request private departures. If family rooms will be available at all accommodations quoted, tour prices will remain as stipulated above, even if tour departure dates are different from scheduled ones.
- Prices for "guided self-drive" safaris will be readily available for the 2011 season only, from 1 Nov 2010 onwards.

## **Travel tips and information.**

- Although your own GSM phone can be used in Namibia, you will only have signal in urban areas.
- Camera, batteries, charger, sun block, hat, sunglasses, comfortable walking shoes and Bathing Costumes.
- Although the weather is good all year around, it is recommended to bring a jacket for the cold evenings during winter times.
- With the exception of (NAMETOEXT01 and NAMPREM01), we do not travel in malaria areas and therefore prophylaxis is not required for most of our safaris.
- Bring your own personal medication.
- You must be in perfect health to undertake any safari.
- You will visit remote areas with little or no medical facilities
- Your valid passport/ visa with at least 6 months to expiry date.
